CURRICULUM

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The program is open to qualified Christian workers and ministry leaders who possess the Master of Arts or Master of Divinity degree from a recognized theological school and have had a minimum of four years of significant ministry experience. Applicants must be engaged in a recognized ministerial or organizational function at the time of application. The prospective student must demonstrate commitment and diligence in academic study and fulfillment of course requirements.

Application fee: PHP 550 (USD 15 for foreigners)
NEO PI-R (Personality Inventory Test): PHP 550 (USD 15 for foreigners)

Submission of duly filled out application form (request by email: registrar@ags.edu.ph)

Certified true copy of Master of Arts or Master of Divinity transcript of academic records

Recommendation from three (3) responsible individuals who are acquainted with the applicant's character and potential for acceptable level of performance in the Doctor of Ministry program, at least one of whom must be a former professor in the applicant's most recent postgraduate academic degree study.

Interview with a Program faculty or the Program Director.

Tuition and related fees. The tuition is P10,000 for each subject. The student will be charged for study materials and other expenses.
